LENT:

- Holy Thursday (28.3.24) Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper, 6:30pm at St Mary's
- Good Friday (29.3.24) Celebration of the Passion of the Lord, 3pm at St Philip Neri
- Holy Saturday (30.3.24) Vigil and First Mass of Easter, 7pm at St Mary's
- Easter Sunday (31.3.24) Easter Sunday Mass, 10am at Immaculate Heart

As we draw ever nearer to the joyous celebration of the risen Lord, we give thanks to God for all that He has made. Let us rejoice that through the power of Jesus' resurrection, all things are made new. May this renewal inspire us to do what we can to bring about a change for the better in our lives and in our world. Thank you all for you continued efforts with pupil attendance this term.

As you will know, we have been monitoring several pupils whose attendance for the year was below the 95% threshold at February half term (without significant reason to be). We are pleased to say that most pupils passed their monitoring; we will be writing to parents/carers to inform them of the outcomes of the monitoring.

Let's see if we can make the Summer Term even more successful and try to attain our school target of 97% attendance for the year!

UNIFORM REMINDER:

Please be reminded, summer uniform items may be worn from start of Summer Term but are not compulsory.

As you ready your child's summer uniform, and acquire any items requiring replacement, please ensure that you make purchases in line with the school's uniform policy.

In particular:

- Pupils should not be wearing black trainers to school. School shoes should be black leather (or leather substitute), polishable and easily fastened.
- Pupils should not be wearing leggings or legging shorts as PE kit. All pupils should be wearing plain, navy tracksuit/jogging pants or plain, royal blue shorts.

Please also ensure that any summer haircuts are in line with school policy.

In particular:

- There should be no shaved designs in hair.
- There should be no dyed hair.
- Shoulder length hair should be always tied back.
